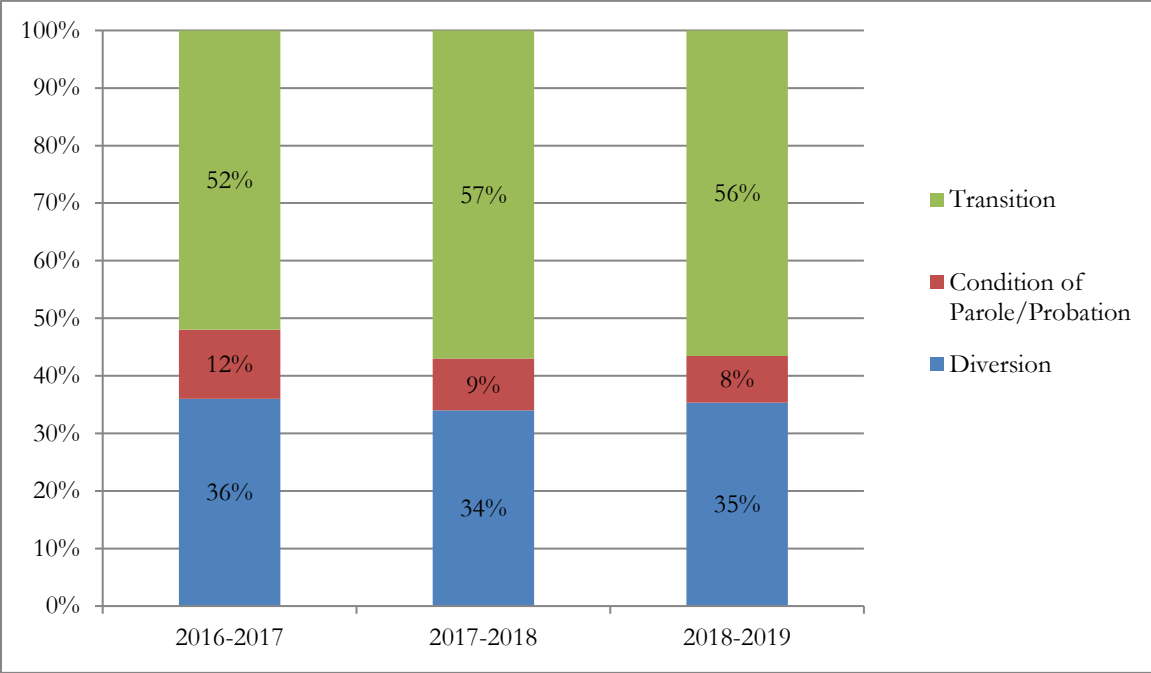

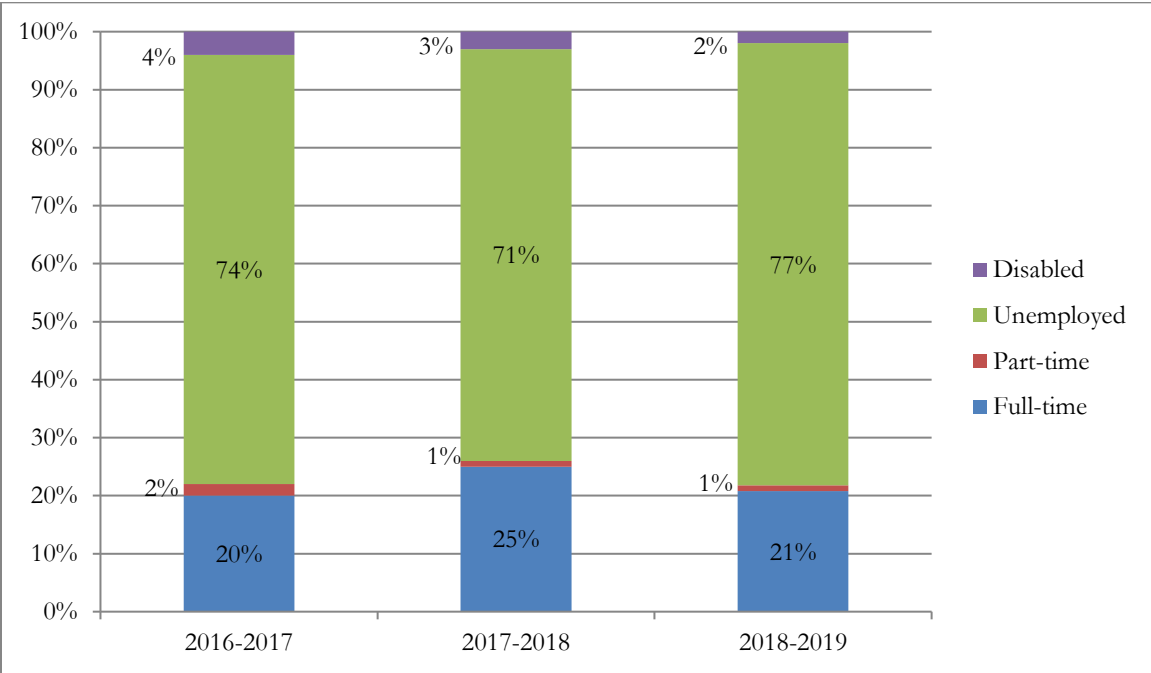

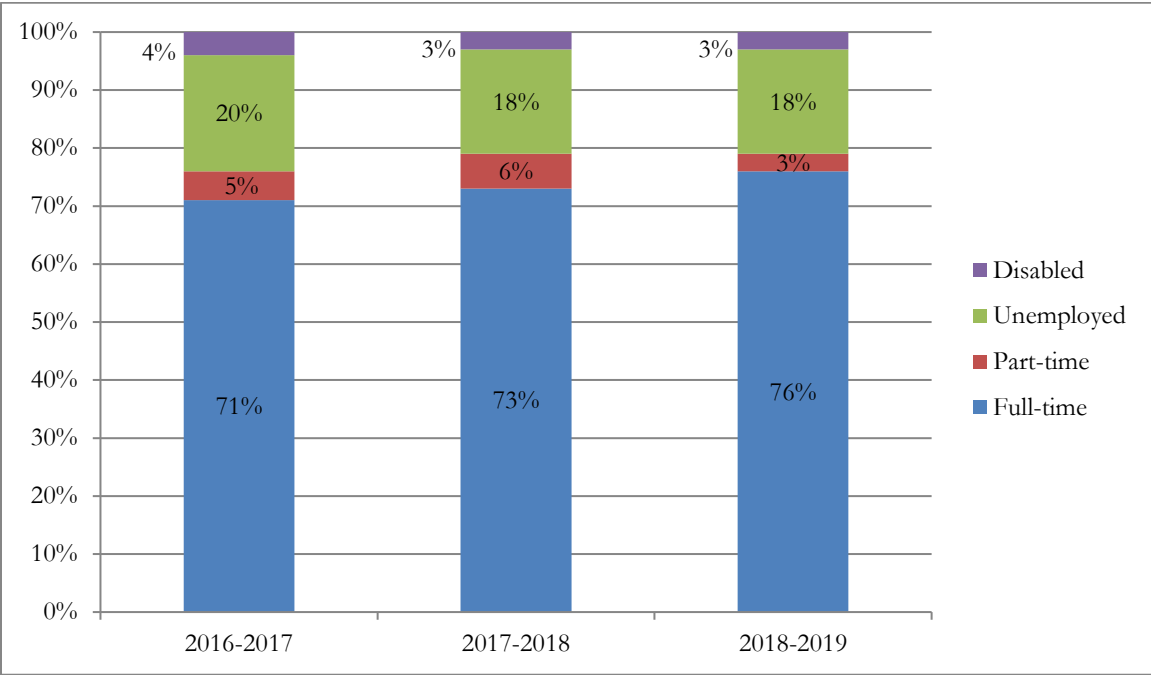
Offender Service Type



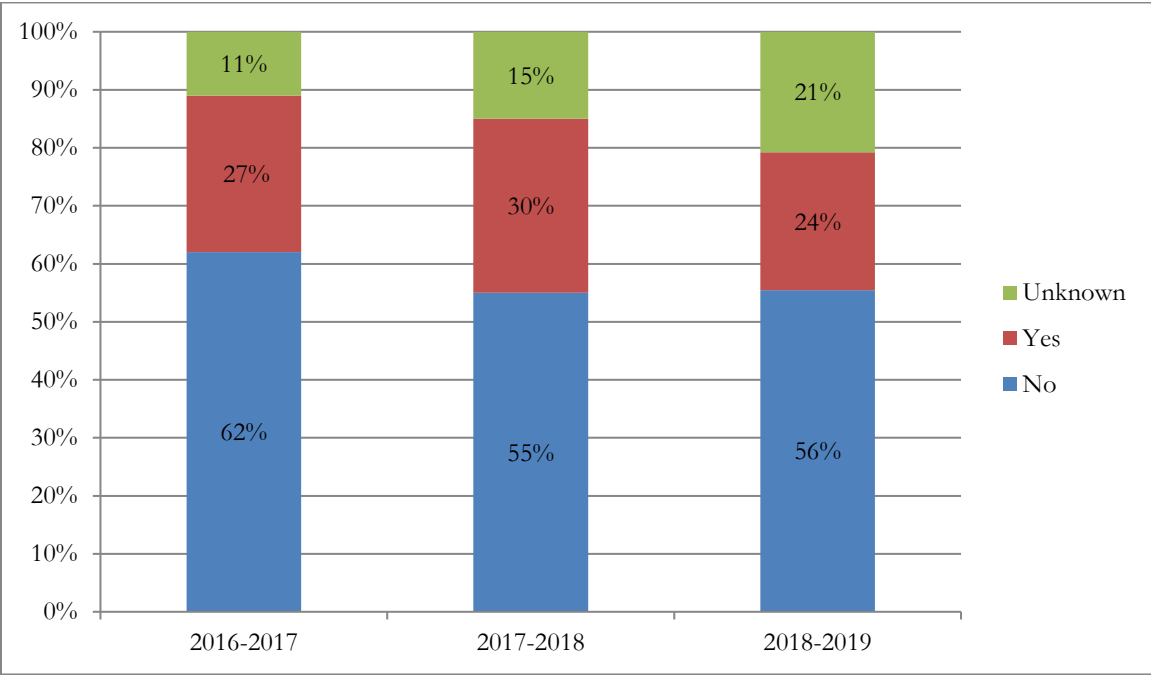
Employment at Entry



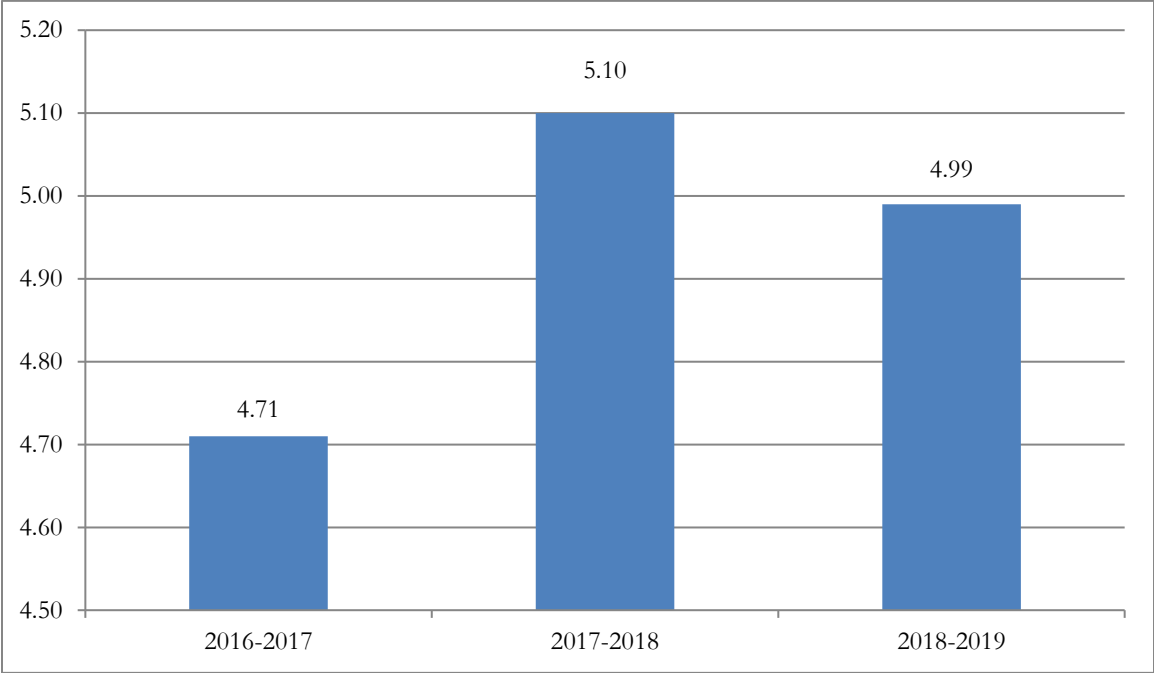
Employment at Termination



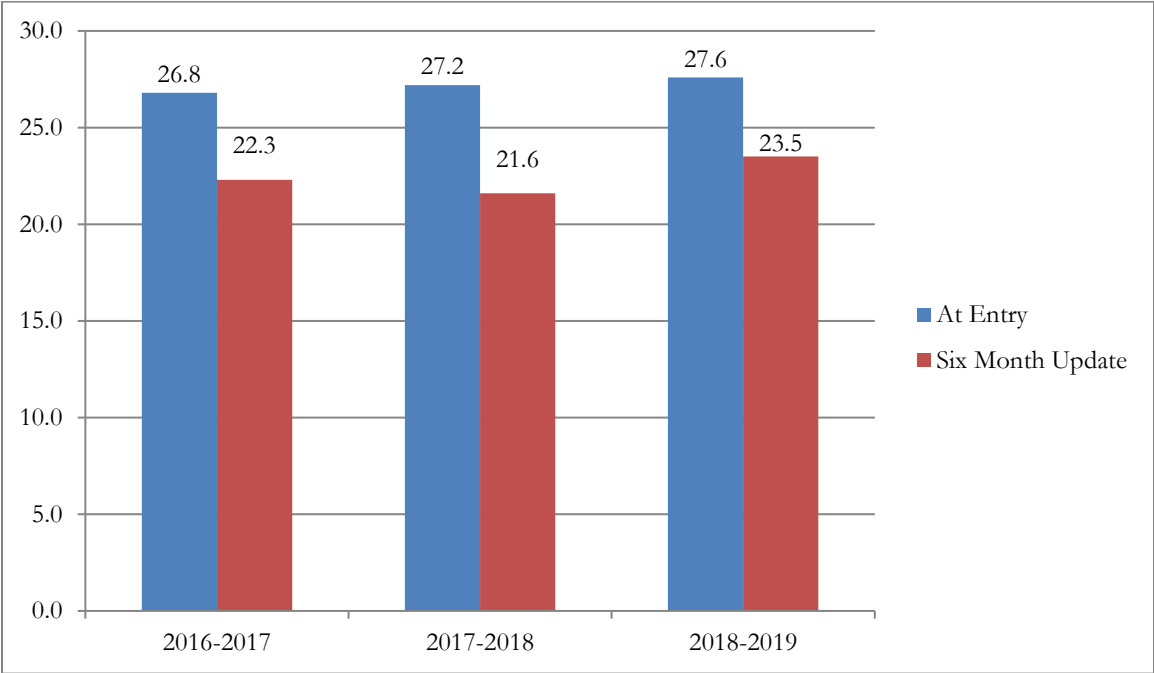
Mental Health Diagnosis



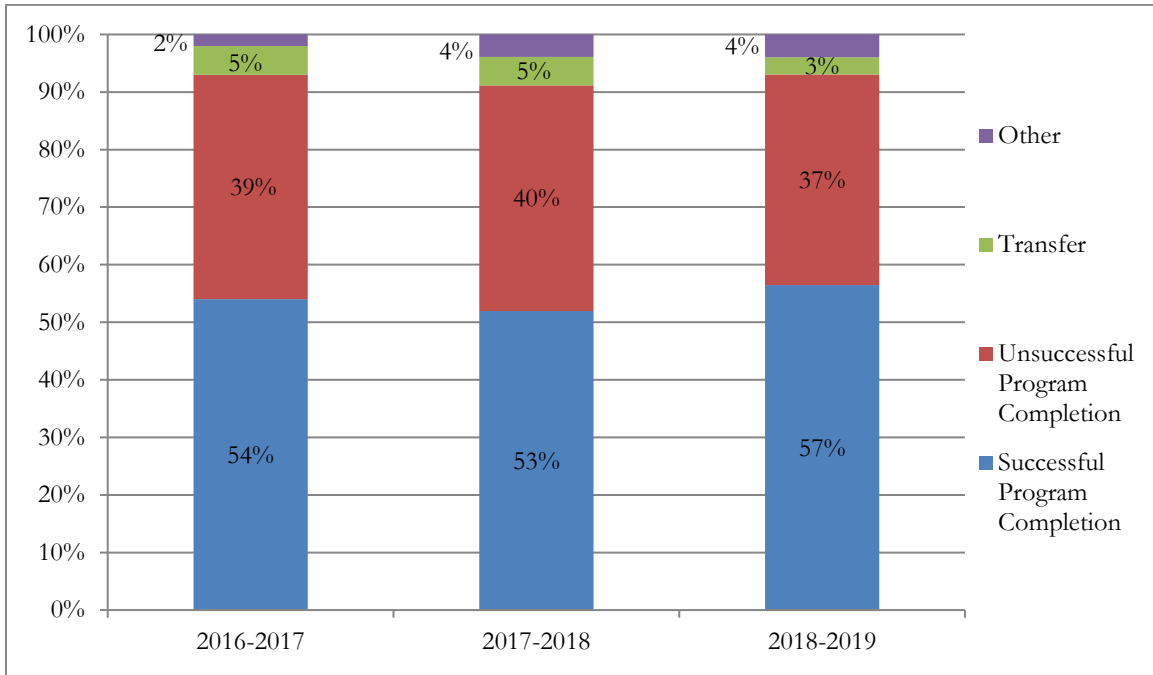
Average SSI Total Score



Average LSI Total Scores

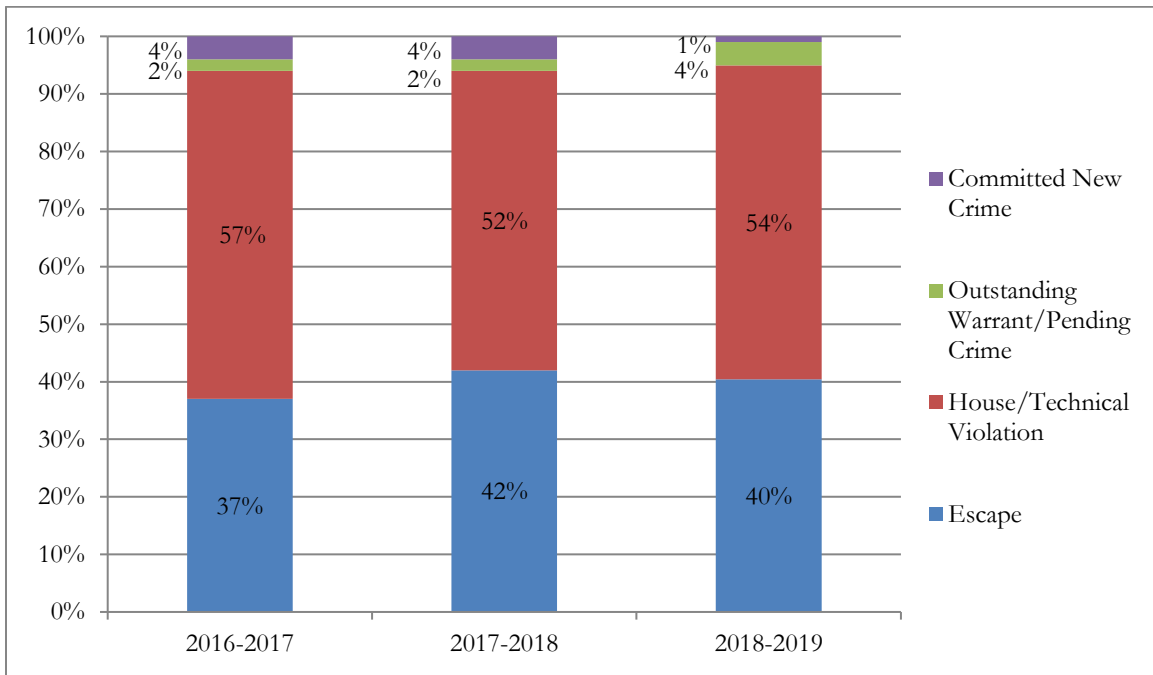


Termination Reason
