CURRENT CRIME DATA AVAILABLE ON ARAPAHOE SHERIFF'S WEB-SITE

On Friday August 25, 2006, the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office will initiate a unique effort to share timely and localized crime data with our community. The Sheriff's Office **Crime Mapping Project** will provide access to localized crime data through the application of an interactive, user-friendly format that utilizes the technology of geographic mapping and statistical data collection. The crime mapping information, available through the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office web-site at www.arapahoesherriff.org, will provide our community with the opportunity to access statistical information related to criminal activity reported to their Sheriff's Office.

The Sheriff's Office interactive **Crime Mapping Project** will provide access to timely crime data related to a specific location or from a geographical area of up to three (3) miles from identified locations. Those interested in accessing the Sheriff's Office crime mapping data may customize information searches by date, date ranges, address, specific homeowners associations, parks, schools and zip codes.
