**MEDIA RELEASE**  
**Suspicious Incident**

Earlier this week a young middle-eastern male was found wandering the halls of Arapahoe High School at 2201 E. Dry Creek Rd. The male is described as being in his late teens or early twenties and was clean-shaven. Upon being contacted by school staff, the subject stated that he was interested in obtaining information regarding GED qualifications and testing. The subject informed school staff that he had recently moved to the area and had been accepted to a nationally recognized University. After a brief discussion with school authorities, the subject left the office area and walked about the interior of the facility for several minutes. Once re-contacted by school staff, the subject left the building without further conversation.

Due to the suspicious nature of the subject's actions and as he has not been identified, the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office is interested in contacting the subject to determine the legitimacy of this incident.

With the assistance of one school staff member, investigators of the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office have completed a composite drawing of the subject. (See attached composite drawing).
