## BOSIER URGES VOTERS TO BRING IDENTIFICATION ON FEB. 24

### – Baker Recall Election Will Be First Affected by New Identification Law –

**LITTLETON, CO (Feb. 12, 2004)** – Arapahoe County Assessor and designated recall election official Ed Bosier issued a reminder to County voters today to bring an acceptable form of identification with them to the polling place if they intend to vote Feb. 24 on the question of recalling Arapahoe County Clerk & Recorder Tracy Baker.

During the 2003 session, the Colorado General Assembly enacted legislation requiring voters to present an official form of identification at a polling place. Any *one* of the following is considered an acceptable form of identification:

1. A current and valid Colorado drivers license
2. A current and valid Colorado Department of Revenue issued identification card
3. A current and valid United States passport
4. A current, valid employee identification card with a photograph of the eligible voter issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the U.S. government or of Colorado or by any county, municipality, board authority or other political subdivision of Colorado
5. A current and valid pilot's license with a photograph of the eligible voter issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other authorized agency of the United States
6. A current and valid U.S. military identification card with a photograph of the eligible voter

7. A copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector

Acceptable forms of identification must reflect a Colorado address. Those failing to bring acceptable identification may be required to vote by provision ballot.

### **About the Arapahoe County Assessor's Office**

The Assessor's Office discovers, lists, classifies and values all real and personal property in Arapahoe County. The Office is also responsible for maintaining public records, including ownership and parcel maps; submitting the Abstract of Assessment to the Colorado Division of Property Taxation; certifying values to taxing entities; and producing the warrant roll. The Arapahoe County Assessor, Ed Bosier, began working for the Office in 1987 as a certified appraiser/supervisor in Land Development. Voters first elected him to the Office of the Assessor in 1995. He is currently serving his third term, which expires January of 2007.
