**When:** Wednesday July 21, 7 p.m.

**Where:** Castlewood Grange Hall, 7275 S. Lima, Englewood

**What:** **Arapahoe County Fashion Revue.** Snap an original as budding 4-H Club designers parade their creations for fashion awards in various categories, including clothing construction, creative sewing, 'Decorate your Duds', leather craft, and wearable Heritage Arts. Admission is free.

**When:** Friday July 23 and Saturday July 24, 9 a.m.

**Where:** Quint Valley Fairgrounds, Byers

**What:** **Arapahoe County Horse Show.** 4-H horse-owners will saddle up to be tested on their equine knowledge, skills and showmanship in the English Horse Show and Gymkhana on Friday, and the Halter and Western Show on Saturday. Friday's show will also feature cattle events, including steer daubing, breakaway calf roping, and working cow horse skills. Admission is free.

The 2004 Arapahoe County Fair opened Saturday, July 17 with a 4-H Dog Show. All show exhibitors are bona fide 4-H members in Arapahoe County, at least 8 years of age and not older than 19 as of January 1, 2004.
