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What are you waiting for? Register to vote by October 4, 2004

In order to vote in the Nov. 2, 2004 General Election, voters must register by Oct. 4, 2004.

To register to vote, a person must be 18 years of age or older on Nov. 2, 2004, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the State of Colorado and live in the precinct in which the person intends to register at least 30 days prior to the election.

To register, you must mail or deliver the Voter Registration Application Form to the County Clerk and Recorder's Office no later than 29 days before the election in which you want to vote. Your eligibility to vote will be based on the postmark date if you mail the form. If you file this form in person, your eligibility to vote will be based on the date you file this form. The Voter Registration Application Form also is available in Spanish.

You may register to vote at any office of the County Clerk and Recorder, at any City Clerk's office, or at any Colorado Driver's License office. If you have moved, you may update your voter registration record at any of these locations or by mail.

First-time voters in the State of Colorado who are mailing the registration application must submit a **copy** of one of the accepted types of identification with the mail-in registration form. The accepted types of identification are listed on page 2 of the mail-in application form. **Do not include original documents with the application.**

New this year: Voters who vote early or at the polls on Election Day will need a valid form of identification to vote. Acceptable forms of identification include a valid Colorado driver's license; U.S. passport; identification card issued by the Department of Revenue; U.S. military ID with photograph; employee identification card issued by the federal, state, county, municipality, board, authority, political subdivision; certified copy of a birth certificate; Medicare or Medicaid card; or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck or other governmental document that shows the name and address of the elector.
