Workforce Center offers equal learning opportunities as part of Multicultural Communication Month

Aurora, Colo. --- Arapahoe/Douglas Works! is hosting a free jobseeker workshop aimed specifically at non-native jobseekers, to bridge the job search information gap for experienced and qualified workers who speak basic English and are not familiar with American employment culture.

“Multicultural Communication Month offers us an excellent opportunity to provide customized services that reach all jobseekers, especially those who represent an increasingly significant segment of our local workforce,” said Patricia K. ‘Non-native’ is defined as foreign born, and eligible to work in the United States. The workshop is hosted in three parts, scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on May 5, 11 and 17 at Arapahoe/Douglas Works!, CentrePoint Plaza, 14980 E. Alameda Dr., Aurora. Topics will include:

- How to fill out job application forms
- Do’s and don’ts of job interviews
