Two Suspects Identified In Burglaries In Byers

On May 8, 2005 two burglaries occurred in the Town of Byers. The first was in the early morning at the Sinclair Station on Highway 36; the second was late that night at the Quint Valley Golf Club. Entry to both businesses was by breaking door or window glass to get inside.

The Sinclair station had about \$700 damage with over \$3,000 worth of merchandise taken. Property damage at the Quint Valley Golf Club exceeded \$13,000 with over \$3,000 worth of property taken.

An investigative lead followed up lead to the identification of two suspects. Both of them are 17 year-old males. One suspect was interviewed along with his parents, and confessed to being involved in both burglaries. An interview was attempted with the second suspect and his parents. Some of the stolen property has been recovered. Other items were recovered not related to these two burglaries, but may be from other burglaries or thefts in the area.

The investigation is continuing. No photos are available due to the suspects being juveniles.
