Bank Robbery

On May 19, 2005 at approximately 9:21 AM the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Communication Center received a report of a bank robbery at:

**First Bank
2323 East Arapahoe Road
Centennial, CO 80122**

According to the bank staff a suspect and vehicle described as:

**B/M, 6'0", 190 lbs. Approximately 35-40 years old
Last seen wearing a Gray T-shirt, Dark pants &
carrying a black bag. Drove away from the scene in a
Silver Ford Taurus.**

The suspect announced a robbery and was given cash by a bank teller. No one at the scene was injured. Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the scene and surrounding areas where a multi-jurisdictional perimeter was established. Four Littleton Public Elementary Schools (Twain, Franklin, Hopkins, Highlands) were locked down for the safety and security of their students and staff. A search of local neighborhoods is ongoing at this time.
