### **Gardening on the Prairie *Homeowners learn how to have a beautiful garden that conserves water too***

**Littleton, Colo.** --- Arapahoe County's CSU Extension Office and Aurora Water host Gardening on the Prairie, a series of short seminars that will show homeowners and gardeners how to create and maintain a beautiful, lower-maintenance yard.
