Arapahoe County opens new Driver's License Renewal Office

Centennial location opens at 12600 E. Arapahoe Road March 19, Open House April 12

Littleton, Colo. - The Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder's Office will open a second driver's license location at the current Southeast Motor Vehicle facility in Centennial on Monday, March 19. An Open House will be held 1:30 to 4 p.m., Thursday, April 12 for citizens to become acquainted with the new service.

The new location – at 12600 E. Arapahoe Road, Building C, Suite B in Centennial - will be the second driver's license office operated by the Clerk and Recorder's Office. Citizens currently can renew their driver's license at the County Administration Building, 5334 S. Prince St., Littleton. Both locations are open 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Services offered include Colorado Driver's license renewal, out-of-state transfers, Colorado Identification cards, transfer of a permit to a Driver's License with the BOST form, motorcycle endorsement, downgrade of CDL licenses, and name and address changes. Citizens also can register to vote and become an organ donor.

“This new location will be convenient for all citizens, but particularly those Arapahoe County residents who have both Motor Vehicle and Driver's License issues,” said Nancy Doty, Clerk and Recorder. “Now, our citizens will be able to complete all transactions at one location, and avoid the long lines.”

Due to State budget cuts, a number of Colorado operated Driver's License offices have closed. This has resulted in long lines and up to two-to-four hour waits at some locations. In an effort to address wait times and the inconvenience to citizens, Doty approached the Department of Revenue about opening another driver's license location in Arapahoe County.
