Senior Housing

Amity Plaza – Littleton Housing Authority 303-795-0462

Low cost housing offering one-bedroom units to qualified seniors. Building is wheelchair accessible. Small pets are allowed. 200 W. Sterne Parkway Littleton, CO 80120-3820

Bradley House - Littleton Housing Authority (303) 794-9608

Provides low cost housing (one-bedroom apartments) for qualified seniors. Small pets are allowed.

Family Public Housing – Littleton Housing Authority (303) 794-9608

Low cost housing is offered to families and seniors. Offers two and three bedroom duplexes and three, four, and five bedroom single-family homes.

Geneva Village - Littleton Housing Authority (303) 794-9608

Facility with twenty-eight apartments; buffets, one-bedroom, two-bedroom units for seniors.

Libby Bortz Assisted Living Center - Littleton Housing Authority (303) 347-9755

Seniors age 62 and older; individual cannot make over \$23,400 annually; maximum for couples is \$26,760.

Orchard Place Subsidized Housing - Englewood Housing Authority (303) 761-6200

Subsidized building with 100 one-bedroom units for seniors and persons with disabilities. Building is wheelchair accessible. Small pets are allowed.

Simon Center Subsidized Housing - Englewood Housing Authority (303) 761-6200

Subsidized building with 104 one-bedroom units. Building is wheelchair accessible. Small pets are allowed. Seniors age 62 and older, persons with disabilities; must qualify by income and assets.

Subsidized Housing - Alyson Court Littleton Housing Authority (303) 794-9608

Facility with sixty subsidized one-bedroom units for seniors and persons with disabilities. Building is wheelchair accessible. Small pets are allowed with a deposit, one per unit.

Family Housing

Family Tree House of Hope

(303) 762-9525

House of Hope is a 24-hour residential family resource center that assists homeless and very-low income families to become self-sufficient and find, safe, affordable housing. Services include shelter, meals, basic needs, case management and counseling. Families are comprised of women heads of household with children. Maximum length of stay is 90 days.

Family Public Housing – Littleton Housing Authority (303) 794-9608

Low cost housing is offered to families and seniors. Offers two and three bedroom duplexes and three, four, and five bedroom single-family homes.

John W. Newey Jr. Family Housing - Littleton Housing Authority (303) 795-0462

Low cost housing provided to low income families. Offers two, three, and four bedroom units.

Transitional Housing Assistance - Inter-Faith Community Services (303) 789-0501

Offers transitional housing assistance, including subsidized cost and case management for a two year period.
