

Arapahoe County Land Development Code

PART 1 ZONING REGULATIONS

SECTION 200 PLANNING COMMISSION

1-201 APPOINTMENTS

- The Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a Planning Commission. The members of the Board shall be ex-officio members of the Planning Commission. Each member shall be a resident within the County. Planning Commission members shall serve a term of three years.

1-202 COMPENSATION

- The Planning Commission shall receive compensation in an amount determined by the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners shall provide for reimbursement of the members of the Planning Commission for actual expenses incurred.

1-203 OFFICERS

- The Planning Commission shall elect each year a Chairman and Chairman Pro Tem from among its members. The Planning Commission may create other offices, as it deems necessary.

1-205 MEETINGS

- The Planning Commission shall establish regular meeting times and places as is necessary to properly and expeditiously process land use applications and other business of the Commission.

1-206 MINUTES

- Minutes of Planning Commission meetings shall be kept and shall be a public record.

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1-207 RULES AND PROCEDURES

- The Planning Commission may adopt rules and procedures as it deems necessary for the proper conduct of its business which are consistent with the rules contained herein and the statutes of the State of Colorado. A matter is deemed submitted to the Planning Commission on the date of the first public meeting at which the item is listed as an item for consideration.

1-208 QUORUM AND VOTE

- The majority vote of the Planning Commission quorum shall be necessary to forward any land use recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners. In the case of a Location & Extent, the majority vote of the Planning Commission quorum shall be necessary to approve or deny such application.
