## Prevent Burglaries While Moving

The summer can be a great time to move into a new house, or for college kids, in to a dorm or apartment. These times can be hectic and with all that is going on some things can “disappear” in the move. To prevent any thefts or losses just follow these tips to make sure you have a clean transition into your new house.

- Have someone to help you move.
- If you can have some one watch the items getting unloaded from the vehicle(s) in to the house.
- Label all boxes and items. (Have a check sheet to match the boxes too).
- Label all boxes and items with your name, number, and new address.
- In each box have a list of what is in there to make sure all items are accounted for.
- Try and move when there are not a lot of people around so you can keep a close eye on all of your possessions.
- If possible, take a couple of trips when moving. That way you will have a smaller load that is more manageable.
