# ARAPAHOE COUNTY OPEN BURNING BAN SUSPENDED

On June 30, 2008, in consideration of the potential for extreme fire danger in Arapahoe County, Sheriff Grayson Robinson issued an Open Burning Ban for Unincorporated Arapahoe County and the City of Centennial. The weather conditions that necessitated the Open Burning Ban have abated. Significant rainfalls, and milder forecasts, have caused the fire danger in Unincorporated Arapahoe County and the City of Centennial to be modified.

The Sheriff's Office and local fire departments will continue to closely monitor the potential for fire danger in Unincorporated Arapahoe County and the City of Centennial. Although the level of danger for possible fires has been modified, everyone must continue to exercise reasonable safety precautions, as well as extreme caution, when engaged in open burning or any fire.
